Imagine a child who cannot see, cannot speak, cannot walk, and moves in great uncontrollable spasms.

This is not fiction. You're seeing just a bit of Randy Reid. But not all of him. Randy's life has been ruled in many ways by the debilitating physical limitations he has endured since birth.

But inside that body is a brain and a spirit that is very much alive.

Tragically, Randy was damaged during a traumatic birth and was soon diagnosed with cerebral palsy, and later blindness. He cried constantly for weeks, barely eating or sleeping.

It was SOUND that finally calmed baby Randy. His parents bought a record player; and when music filled the room, the child stopped crying.

As Randy grew, his parents did their very best to care for him. Isolated by his disabilities, little Randy was frustrated. He wanted to live and grow, but he wasn't able to attend school, walk, or talk. Once again, a record player saved Randy's sanity. When he was eight years old, the family discovered audio books for the blind through their local library.

"Randy just blossomed when he started listening to talking books," says his mother, Dot. His first book was Old Yeller, and he loved it. "He would sit in his room and listen to that story being told for hours and hours!" remembers his mother.

But there was a problem. More and more books arrived with inappropriate content. The librarian explained that nearly all their audio books would contain at least some sex, violence, or bad language.
